- Work effectively with paraprofessionals and participate in classroom activities.
- Facilitate social interactions.
- Prepare students for transition and facilitate independence.

Day 2:

Behavior Solutions, and Curriculum Modifications/Adaptions

Participants will...

- Interpret the meaning of challenging behaviors and implement effective strategies.
- Use social story and visual supports in the classroom to improve behaviors.
- Create an effective classroom environment.
- Develop and implement adapted curriculum.
